

## Mid Cheshire College 'Winsford Campus'

A copper clad campus for Cheshire College

*As part of the development of Mid Cheshire College a new £9.6 million campus at Winsford was commissioned. The 3 story new build contains classrooms/ seminar rooms, IT suites, learning resource centre, hair and beauty salon, gymnasium, kitchen and server, cafe and arts rooms.*

Execa, a section of CA Group provided the stunning pre-patinated copper cladding system. The system was chosen for its immediate ability to satisfy the highest aesthetic demands in the building design. Using a specially developed industrial process, the copper sheets are patinated green on one side. This process causes an oxidised layer to form on the surface of the copper – a process similar to the natural patination that occurs over a long period of time



when copper is exposed to atmospheric conditions. The product is always extremely varied, just as you would expect from a natural surface and gives a stunning finish.
